Today, I announce that I will not seek reelection in 2020. It has been my honor, my privilege and my pleasure to serve you, the people of Tuolumne County. It is time, however, for me to move on and provide the opportunity for another to take the reins of the Fifth District and work with the remainder of the Board to lead Tuolumne County going forward.

I want to take this opportunity to thank all the wonderful people who have supported me from 2011 when I ran for District 5 Supervisor the first time up to and including today. You cannot possibly know how much that support has meant to me and how it has continually energized me to do daily what I believe is best for our County of Tuolumne. I will continue to rely on that support as I finish out my term.

I promised to be your fulltime Supervisor back in the 2012 campaign and reaffirmed that pledge when I ran again in 2016. The election results confirmed that was what you wanted, and I have striven to be that Supervisor for the past 6 ½ years. I made the statement in a candidate's event in the 2012 race that I thought if I couldn't get done what I wanted to accomplish in 8 years that it should probably be someone else's turn in the barrel. I have accomplished much of what I set out to and I can foresee accomplishing much of what remains in the coming year and a half.
