Amador, Del Norte, El Dorado, Inyo, Madera, Mariposa, Napa, Nevada, San Diego, San Francisco, Solano, Stanislaus, Sutter, Tehama, and Tuolumne Counties for Public Assistance.
Contra Costa and San Mateo Counties for Public Assistance (already designated for Individual Assistance).
